Internationalization is at the core of the Art and Design College of Corella. We put every effort into facilitating and fostering cross-boundaries exchanges of our students and staff, and most notably, those enhancing their training and internships in foreign companies. In addition, we are delighted to welcome students and staff members from other countries (specially but not exclusively from the European Union) in our school.

Our experience of almost two decades as participants of international programs such as the Leonardo Program (led by the European Commission) and, most recently, the Erasmus + program evinces our full commitment with the internationalization of our institution. Since the year 2000, the Art and Design College of Corella has participated in European programs as a response to the intellectual curiosity of our staff and students for the international projection of their studies and training. This commitment is also in line with our School Education Project and our will to reinforce the link between the technical and artistic studies offered at our school, and an increasingly globalised labor market.

As a public school from Navarra, Spain, we are members of a internationalization consortium led by the Department of Education of Navarra within which we develop our international mobilities.

a) How we choose our partners.

We aim at establishing a network of contacts with organizations and institutions that share training, professional and cultural interests with our school and which may have an interest in our students' profiles.

b) Location preferences.

We are interested in areas that offer an adequate and attractive labor market for our students of VET and Graphic Design higher studies.
